

College Admission Requirements

YOUR FUTURE BEGINS NOW!

COMMUNITY OR STATE COLLEGE

1. Receive one of the 3 Florida diplomas - Standard, Merit or Scholar.

Or,

2. Receive a Certificate of Completion and take the Post-Secondary Education Readiness Test (P.E.R.T.) to determine if you qualify for college-credit courses or if you must take remedial courses to continue college-preparatory studies. Passage of the P.E.R.T. considers the student as "college-ready." Students may substitute a score from the SAT or ACT to meet the P.E.R.T. criteria.

Or,

3. GED (Check with your local college on the status of this diploma.)

A FLORIDA UNIVERSITY

1. Receive one of the 3 Florida diplomas - Standard, Merit or Scholar.

And,

2. Obtain necessary SAT or ACT scores:

SAT

- Critical Reading - 460 or higher
- Mathematics - 460 or higher
- Writing - 440 or higher

ACT

- Reading - 19 or higher
- Mathematics - 19 or higher
- Combined English/Writing - 18 or higher

Or,

Some universities may vary from this requirement.

And,

3. Meet Grade Point Average Requirement (varies by institution).

And,

4. Earn 2 high school credits in 1 foreign language or American Sign Language.

Or,

5. For eligibility with a GED diploma, contact the university or State University System.
